He had reported back in the form of an email following his discussions with Neil Masterman of HCC Highways.

On top of emergency closures of the A337, B3058 – Railway Bridge and B3058 – Bashley Road towards the Rising Sun. There are at least 12 fibre optic companies vying to lay their lines to homes in Highcliffe, Walkford and now Fibre City is looking at installing similar in and around the Barton vicinity.
