

**Livestock grazing is essential** for the conservation of many of England's most important wildlife habitats. New Milton Town Council are responsible for the Ballard Water Meadow site, designated a Site of Importance for Nature Conservation; managed in line with Environmental Stewardship requirements under the **Higher Level Stewardship** scheme.

Previously grazed by a small herd of Dexter cattle, we've now got 4.25 ha of grazing

**available** in the meadow from September to March, year on year, and **we need conservation grazers** to help us maintain this important local wildlife site.

The site benefits from full stock fencing around the meadow and secured gates. Livestock have access to a water trough that is regularly checked.

Dexter cattle would be ideal for this site, but we are happy to discuss other breeds as appropriate.
