51. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

52. CORRESPONDENCE

a) New Forest District Council Planning Committee

Application 22/10418 – 178 dwellings, public open space, alternative natural green space and associated infrastructure, with access onto Gore Road – Land south of Gore Road (NFDC strategic site SS11).

The application received approval, delegated to the Service Manager on completion of Section 106 agreement.

b) Neighbourhood Plan - Ringwood

The referendum held on 4 July returned a positive result (83.2%) and was subsequently 'made' (adopted) by New Forest District Council at their meeting held on 8th July 2024.

c) Tree Preservation Order

Confirmation has been received of the made order protecting an Oak tree to the rear of 60 Brook Avenue North.

d) Solent CO2 Pipeline Project

A public consultation is now underway. It is seeking comments to proposed routes for an underground pipeline to be laid, for carbon capture delivery to Fawley. The 'mainland' route would cut across the National Park from the coastline between Barton and Milford. There are two other options however, being north to west or north to south across the Isle of Wight, and these are the project teams preferred routes.

The pipe measures 1m in width and there would be a 12.5m exclusion zone on either side.

All information can be access via link www.solentco2pipeline.co.uk, the consultation runs until 12 September 2024.

e) Compton Road

Members raised correspondence regarding a Pennyfarthing request to Hampshire Highways, that the Town Council were not notified of. Residents had been in direct contact with members on receipt of the proposal.

Temporary double yellow lines will be added to the length of the road to facilitate site movements at the previous A&T site. The lines will be effective for 18 months, from 6am to 7pm 7 days per week, and due to the lengthy hours will not allow overnight parking for the residents. Residents appeared to receive just two weeks' notice and no consultation, so are understandably upset.

Cllr S Davies had written to Pennyfarthing on the matter, requesting the set hours be reconsidered to allow residents to park outside their properties overnight, with the letter being acknowledged but no resolution offered.

The Chairman requested a letter be sent to Hampshire Highways regarding the lack of consultation to the Town Council and minimal notice given to residents.
