172. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

No update as yet.

173. CORRESPONDENCE

a) Land East of Brockhills Lane – Strategic Site 10

An update has been provided by New Forest District Council –

Installation of roadways, drainage, pathways and other infrastructure is ongoing. Phases 1 and 1a are being levelled and infrastructure for the next stage of these phases is being constructed on site. Road and kerbs are being installed along the western edge of Phase 1. Tree protection is in situ across the whole site.

Plots 8-21 are at foundation level. Plots 6, 7 and 155-157 are at ground floor level. Plots 158-164 are at first floor level. Plots 2-5 are at roofline. Plots 1 and 22 are at internal and external stages and the Site Monitoring Officer checked that these elevations concurred with the agreed plans.

b) Appeal Decision

The following notification was received –

Application 25/10198 – 4 Belmont Road – 2-bedroom bungalow to the rear of 4 Belmont Road – *Appeal Dismissed*.

c) Christchurch Bay and Harbour Strategy

The joint strategy outlining how coastal flood and erosion risk will be managed over the next 100 years has been produced. Created by Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole Council and New Forest District Council, it runs from Hengistbury Head Long Groyne to Hurst Spit. The document provides recommendations for up to three options for each area; National Economic option, Local Aspirational (developed by public views and often costly) and a Back Up option if funding cannot be secured. There is no statutory responsibility to undertake coastal defence works if central government funding is not available, therefore the strategy defaults to the minimum amount of intervention should partnership funding not be feasible.

d) Cliff fall

A further cliff fall, in the same stretch but separate section, fell on 28 December so the cliff top path east of Marine Drive 3 car park to the Barton Common path has been closed. New Forest District Council continue to monitor.

e) Public Declaration Notice

The meeting clerk advised the committee of the declaration of Local Nature Reserve Status for Ballard Meadow and Woodland Local Nature Reserve, following from that stated at Town Council on 5th January. The Communications Officer had requested the Declaration be included in every standing committee meeting for one cycle. A press release will be available soon.


DECLARATION OF BALLARD MEADOW AND WOODLAND LOCAL NATURE RESERVE (*Ballard Local Nature Reserve*) in the Parish of New Milton in the County of Hampshire.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in pursuance of Section 19 of the above-mentioned Act that by the **Local Nature Reserve Declaration BWMLNR 001** made on the day of **24 November 2025** the land **4.25 hectares** or thereabouts situated in the **Parish of New Milton** in the **County of Hampshire** and shown edged in red line on the plan attached to the said Declaration (is the subject of an Agreement entered into with the Council under Section 21 of the above-mentioned Act) and that the said land is being managed as a Nature Reserve.
